

Welcome to Pinnacle Place now offering Hi Definition TV and Wireless Internet Updated September 2012

Following are some guidelines and suggestions to allow Pinnacle Place Owners to enjoy new entertainment equipment to the maximum:

These new flat screens originate the picture from the sides and create some heat.....please pull out a bit from the enclosure to allow the heat to dissipate. Please also use caution when turning the TV to avoid bumping the edges of the TV into the enclosure wall.

Using the silver "Charter" control, the "System on/off" button will power up (and down) the cable box and the TV together. Please be sure when turned off that the red light in the lower right corner of the TV is showing and the blue light on the cable box is off.

When you power the blu-ray player the TV should automatically go to that input. When the blu-ray player is turned off the TV will go to the TV input which is not operative so on the large black remote hit the input button at the top, choose HDMI 1 with the up – down arrows and then press the button in the center of the arrows.

Blu ray players are or will soon be connected to the internet to allow individuals to view Blockbuster or NetFlix programming with an established account.

The blu-ray players will accept regular DVD's as well as CD's and MP3 discs.

The "menu" button will provide a guide to all menus including the Hi Def programming and the music channels. Use the left – right arrows to choose "HD" and press "OK" then select "HD Channel Guide" to see all channels that are available in Hi Def.

Wireless internet is operative in all units and your equipment will be able to access several units depending on your location. Please access your unit internet as this will be the strongest signal for you. These are presently unsecured access points so use with security within your own equipment.
